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Required Course Materials: Students must be prepared with the following materials when they come to class:

- Two pencils (or more) for note-taking and class activities
- Notebook or loose-leaf paper
- Folder or section in binder for all Social Studies materials
- Fully charged iPad
- Headphones (Only for EDpuzzle videos)

<u>Course Design</u>: Seventh grade Social Studies is uniquely designed with the student in mind. Guided discovery is essential, and the prospect of growth is daily. Through technology, group activities, and analysis, students will contribute to a positive learning environment. Each and every student will be able to express creativity, foster growth, and evaluate real world experiences. These experiences will manifest a positive and productive citizen with content and character at the forefront.

<u>Course Objectives</u>: By the end of this academic semester the student will *understand*, *apply*, *explain*, *summarize*, *connect*, *analyze*, *compare/contrast*, and *draw conclusions* from the following Social Studies areas:

 World Geography, History and Culture: Patterns of Continuity and Change (North Carolina's Essential Standards)

<u>Instructional Strategies</u>: May include the following: interactive lecture, guided notes, class discussions, small group activities, peer teaching, graphic organizers, comparative analysis, media, guided readings, individual study, silent reading, geography activities, critical thinking questions, and primary source analysis activities.

<u>Assessments</u>: Students will be formally and/or informally assessed on a daily basis. Forms of assessment include formal tests/quizzes (i.e. multiple choice, matching, fill-in-the-blank, written response), creative projects, writing assignments, research reports, map activities, timelines, question and answer, graphic organizers, and homework assignments.

<u>Assignments/Homework</u>: Students <u>must</u> turn in assigned work when it is due. For work that is turned in past the due date, there is a 10 point deduction. Throughout the semester there will be assignments on paper and on Canvas.

Grade Determination: The breakdown of my grading policy is as follows:

- Tests 30%
- Proiects 20%
- Classwork 20%
- Quizzes 15%
- Choice Board 15%

Classroom Agreements:

- 1. Always respect yourself, your teacher, your peers, and your environment (classroom, class materials, hallways, cafeteria, etc.).
- 2. Do not talk when someone else myself or one of your peers is talking. Wait your turn and do not interrupt others!

Class Procedures:

Beginning of Class:

- Come to class prepared.
- Be on time.
- iPads must be placed under desks when not being used for instructional purposes.
- Leave all food, candy & drink outside of the classroom. (Bottled water is allowed)

- Stay on task.
- Be courteous.
- Follow directions the first time they are given.
- Raise your hand do not shout out answers or speak out of turn.
- Walk in quietly, sit in your assigned seat, and take out materials needed for the bellringer activity (usually a pencil and a sheet of paper)
- Immediately begin working on the Bell Ringer (warm-up) activity
 - o Directions and the activity will be projected onto the board

During Class:

- Be respectful
- Stay focused (stay on-task)
- No cell phones
- iPads must be placed under desks when not being used in instruction
- Follow classroom rules

End of Class:

- Wait until you are instructed to do so before you begin packing up
- Once you have been dismissed you may get out of your seat
- Quietly walk to your next class

<u>Make-Up Work Policies</u>: A student has the same number of days to make-up work as they missed from school. It is the student's responsibility to get any assignments/classwork they missed due to their absence.

<u>Honor Code</u>: *Academic dishonesty (cheating) is not tolerated.* All students will be referred to administration.
